

Gabriola and Mudge road names

The following is a cumulative list of road and street names that have been published in *SHALE* at one time or another.

Names in the book by Aula Bell and Neil Aitken, *Gabriola Island Place Names*, published in 1996 are listed here, but without any of the detail contained in the book. Road and street names not listed in this book are in **red**.

[Notes](#) are mostly from a local historian/blogger (gabriolore) and are replacement links for his site that is now unavailable, but [archived](#) here. These are additional to any notes in *Gabriola Island Place Names*.

Where there is some disagreement between maps, or between official names and local usage, the [RDN map](#) is given precedence, but in cases where the RDN map disagrees with the street sign, then the street sign takes precedence. An [online street map](#) that is easier to use than the RDN map is here.

Names that are out there, but are probably typographical errors or careless mistakes rather than common alternative usage, are marked (error?). These names are retained in the list to assist computer searches.

The possessive apostrophe is omitted in place names in this list (Browns rather than Brown's). This used to be standard practice for maps and nautical charts.
